



SPARKS' REMARKS

Back in 2005, I issued a stop sale on farm raised seafood products from Vietnam. The stop sale was extended to include grouper, flounder and sole after there were misidentification issues in 2006. The stop sale was ordered due to an import alert in other states regarding the presence of banned antibiotics known as fluoroquinolones, an antibiotic that the FDA has issued a zero-tolerance policy for in food.

At the time, I had a few people ask me what harm could come from an antibiotic. It is true that many of us take antibiotics when we are sick, but sometimes a drug can cause an adverse reaction. When we hear doctors talk about possible allergic reactions to a substance or that it may cause immunity or health problems later, it is easy to think "It won't happen to me." I'm no pharmaceutical expert by any means, but if an expert with the FDA says there is even a 1% possibility of a negative reaction to a specified drug or substance within the United States, then I am going to take notice.

A 1% possibility in the U.S. would mean that up to 3 million people could possibly be affected with an allergic reaction, a drug interaction, or even death. That's about 3/4 of Alabama's population. But, I don't mean to alarm you with this figure. There is not an impending crisis in the food industry, at least not yet. However, if we are not cautious

with what products come into our country I strongly believe we are heading in a dangerous direction.

Take for example the recent Menu Foods, Inc. pet food recall. With over 60 million cans and pouches of wet pet food being recalled across nation, just think of how many pets could have been harmed. Further testing of the products and research of the source of the ingredient has told us the contaminant was from China.

Now, there have been even more pet food product recalls since the first Menu Foods recall back in mid-March. Some dry foods and treats have been found to contain melamine, which is also not registered for use in food products in the U.S. So many pets across the nation have become sick or have died in the last couple of months. I hope this horrible situation shows how important food safety is to us here at home. All it takes is one harmful contaminant to change thousands and possibly even hundreds of thousands of lives. What if instead of our beloved pets, the tainted product was baby formula, or cereal? What is more important than the health of our kids? As parents, we would not take a chance with their health.

People have a right to know that what they are eating and what they are feeding their children and their pets is safe. That is one of the reasons Country of

Over two days in April, Commissioner of Agriculture and Industries Ron Sparks and his staff visited farms in Alabama that received heavy damage due to the late freeze. On the first day, they toured Don Glenn's corn and wheat farm in Hillsboro, Doug Spradlin's apple and peach orchards in Cullman, and Tom Bentley's Farm in Thorsby. On the second day, Governor Bob Riley, Senator Lowell Barron, Representative Butch Taylor and Representative John Robinson, joined the group and visited Bob Deutscher's orchard on Crow Mountain in Fackler.

Commissioner Sparks had expressed his deep concern before the extremely low temperatures occurred. The Department of Agriculture and Industries' staff pursued all measures to prevent damage to the crops and stayed in close contact with Governor Bob Riley's office, Congressman Spencer Bachus and the United

States Department of Agriculture (USDA).

Prior to the freeze it appeared this year's peach crop would have been one of the best farmers have experienced in the past several years. According to reports, peach growers in Chilton County lost about 75% of their crop and fruit growers in North Alabama will lose 100% of this year's crop. Many Alabama farmers planted more corn than in previous years because of the boost in popularity of alternative fuel sources. Now, they must face a rough start to what might have been a remarkable year for Alabama's farmers.

Commissioner Sparks stated, "We are aware of how vital these commodities are to our state's economy and want the farmers to be assured we are exhausting all measures to assist them as they recover from this disastrous crop loss."

"How many times can you face a disaster and get no relief and still expect to keep farming? Alabama produce will become extinct if we don't do something to help them," added Sparks.

Sparks and Governor Riley plan to travel to Washington D.C. later this month to meet with Alabama's Congressional delegation concerning the severe crop loss.

Origin Labeling was initiated last year as a pilot project for fresh vegetables and produce by the Alabama Grocer's Association. We know where everything we buy comes from, whether it's clothing, a big screen TV, or a car. With so many food products coming into our country from around the world, I believe people should have a choice when it comes to what they want to eat even in restaurants. Many food products from other countries are completely safe, but based on testing at our state food lab many products such as the Vietnamese seafood contains banned substances.

In 2002, our lab found chloramphenicol in shrimp. Chloramphenicol is a drug that has been associated with the onset of a condition called aplastic anemia. This condition causes the body not to produce enough red blood cells. Untreated, aplastic anemia can result in death. Just last week, we

completed testing of basa type fish products from Indonesia, Thailand, Malaysia, and Vietnam. Our results have shown that 5 of 13 samples tested positive for fluoroquinolones. Catfish from China were also tested. Out of 20 samples tested, 14 came back with positive results for fluoroquinolones.

And now China is exporting millions of pounds of their home-grown catfish to the US. How do we decide what is safe? I do not know how to say it any plainer: We must demand that other countries provide us with products that live up to the standards we have in the United States. If we do not allow a potentially harmful substance to be used by farmers and producers in our country, then other countries should not be able to send their tainted products to us. It is that simple. We don't think it will happen to us or our family, but it is not a risk I am willing to take.

CRP Practice Available to Restore Longleaf Pine

Longleaf pine forests once covered millions and millions of acres of the coastal plain, from eastern Texas to southeastern Virginia. Human land uses have reduced the number of acres dramatically over the last century, leaving current acreage of longleaf only a fraction of what it once was. Because of this and the many declining wildlife species associated with the longleaf pine ecosystem, the USDA Farm Service Agency (FSA) has recently announced a new practice to help restore longleaf pine on private lands.

FSA has received an allocation of 37,000 acres for the Continuous Conservation Reserve Program (CCRP) practice CP-36. This practice was created to help restore the dwindling longleaf pine ecosystem. This new practice has a total allocation of 250,000 acres of longleaf pine as the goal for nine southern states including Alabama.

The purpose of this practice is to establish longleaf pine

stands at densities that benefit wildlife and protect water quality. This not only includes planting longleaf seedlings, but also planting native grasses, and the use of prescribed fire. Eligible producers are those that have owned or operated the land offered for 12 months prior to the close of signup.



Eligible land is cropland that has been planted or considered planted to an agricultural row-crop commodity four of the years 1996 to 2001 and is physically capable of being planted in a normal manner. The soils must be suitable for longleaf pines, which are generally sandy, well drained soils. The local FSA office has a listing of approved longleaf soils.

The land offered must also be located within the National Longleaf Priority Area, which covers the natural range of long leaf pine. For Alabama, 52 of the 67 counties are eligible. Check with your local FSA office to see if your county is within this area.

Contracts approved for Practice CP-36 will receive an annual rental payment for 10 to 15 years, a one-time signup bonus of \$100 per acre, a one-time Practice Incentive Payment equal to 40% of the eligible installation costs, and financial assistance up to 50% of the eligible reimbursable practice costs. Including the Practice Incentive Payment, a landowner can get up to 90% cost-share on planting longleaf pine and native grasses under this program.

Sign-up will run continuously until the 37,000 acres for Alabama is enrolled, or December 31, 2007, whichever comes first. Applications will be approved on a first come first served basis as approved conservation plans are completed.
